

Changes to Khoury League Rule-Books, Implemented 1-13-07

Baseball Rules:

Rule 10: Playing Rules

Section 12: Page 38, Current Baseball Rule Book (Green Book)

First Paragraph shall read:

In the Atom, Bantam and Midget Divisions only, each registered and roster player must be allowed to play nine (9) defensive outs in a regular season scheduled game, tournament and/or National Playoffs, unless, the game is shorten and called an official game by some other rules provisions, such as the 10-run rule, weather and Etc.

During the course of the game, other than pitching rules, which must be followed in accordance to the rule book, a player may be “Free Substituted” during the course of the game, in the eight (8) other defensive positions, during the game to fulfill playing the mandatory nine (9) outs in a defensive position.

All players in attendance at a game shall be listed in a batting order, and all players shall bat “In Round Robin Order” during the duration of the game. The goal is that each player shall bat at least one time during a game. Once the game has started, the batting order cannot be changed, other than removing a player from the list due to injury, illness or some other proper circumstance.

Note: Any other sections, or sub-sections in Rule 10, Section 12, that are contradictory to the above are hereby void.

Softball Rules:

Rule 10: Playing Rules

Section 12: Page 34 Current Softball Rule Book (Blue Book)

First Paragraph shall read:

In the Pixie, Petite, and Chic Divisions only, each registered and roster player must be allowed to play nine (9) defensive outs in a regular season scheduled game, tournament and/or National Playoffs, unless, the game is shorten and called an official game by some other rules provisions, such as the 10-run rule, weather and Etc.

During the course of the game, other than pitching rules, which must be followed in accordance to the rule book, a player may be “Free Substituted” during the course of the game, in the eight (8) other defensive positions, during the game to fulfill playing the mandatory nine (9) outs in a defensive position.

All players in attendance at a game shall be listed in a batting order, and all players shall bat “In Round Robin Order” during the duration of the game. The goal is that each player shall bat at least one time during a game. Once the game has started, the batting order cannot be changed, other than removing a player from the list due to injury, illness or some other proper circumstance.
